THE PRIMARY EDUCATION AT MODERNAGE

Children studying in Grade I to V and of ages 6 to 10 years are included in the Primary Level. At the Primary Level, the children are learning new things every day. They are making friends, developing their skills, and becoming more confident. At Modernage, we focus on helping them build a strong foundation, especially in core subjects of languages, Math, and Science for a bright future.



OBJECTIVES OF PRIMARY AT MODERNAGE

At Modernage, the objectives of the Primary Level are aligned with the National Curriculum of Pakistan. They are to:



provide strong foundations in core subjects i.e. languages, Math and Science

develop communication skills of the child to such a level that they can communicate their ideas and needs with fluency

create independent, confident, self-assured and polite individuals

ensure social, physical, cultural and ethical development of the child

create awareness about personal hygiene and self-care as well as care for environment

inculcate a sense of citizenship and acceptance for cultural diversity

ACADEMIC BREAKUP

Abbottabad Region

The academic year is split into two terms for Primary:

i. First Term:
From 1st week of March till the end of June.

ii. Final Term:
From 1st week of August till December.
There are two major breaks in an academic year.
The summer vacation lasts for one month and the
winter vacation is for 10 to 11 weeks.


Capital Region

The academic year is split into two terms for Primary:

i. First Term:
From 1st week of August till end of December

ii. Final Term:
From 3rd week of January till end of May
There are two major breaks in an academic year.
The summer vacation lasts for 8 to 10 weeks and
the winter vacation is for 2 to 3 weeks.

The Schedule of Activities has the detail of all holidays and vacation. It is uploaded on the Parents Portal/App & website. Beside all gazetted holidays, Saturdays and Sundays are observed as weekly holidays and Friday is a half-day.





LEARNING ENVIRONMENT AT MODERNAGE

The classrooms at Modernage are designed to facilitate diverse learning styles, with areas that encourage children to explore and learn through play. Our environment is stimulating and purposeful, with thought-provoking displays. An integral part of the learning environment in a classroom are the relationships and the routines that the teacher establishes while working with the children. We believe that the triangle of the child, environment and teachers should extend beyond the school and include parents and the wider community so as to facilitate learning in and beyond the classroom.



THE HOMEROOM LESSON

It is the first lesson of just 10 minutes immediately after the Morning Assembly. In this lesson, the class teacher takes attendance, discusses policies, checks uniforms, and makes important announcements if any. The children are also encouraged to talk about the problems that they might be facing at school in this time.

Your child should be able to do the homework in your supervision at home. Homework is daily sent by the teachers in the Class WhatsApp groups according to a Homework Schedule issued to all the classes.

Develop a firm routine for homework.


Allocate a specific time and study area.

ASSESSMENTS, TESTS, EXAMINATION & GRADING POLICY

Grades I & II:

In these classes Formative Assessment is conducted throughout the term to form a very clear picture of the skills learnt by the child. At the end of each term, end of term assessments are conducted in a very child friendly environment, without the fear of exams. The samples of students' work are collected in Students Portfolios which are presented to the parents in the Parent-Teacher Meetings.



ASSESSMENTS, TESTS, EXAMINATION & GRADING POLICY

Grades III to V:

i. Monthly Grand Tests:

In the months of March, April, May, August and September, these forty minutes tests are conducted. The date sheet and results are intimated through the Portal and App of Modernage.

ii. Daily Grand Tests:

Daily Grand Tests are conducted in the month of November for a comprehensive revision and preparation of Final Exam.

iii. First Term Exam and Final Exam:

A three hour exam is conducted for each subject at midyear and end of the year with due notice of at least 7 days. In addition, there are Oral Examination, Practical exams, Projects, Nazra, Listening and Speaking activities, Oral Times Tables, Reading and Recitations.





ACADEMIC STANDARDS & PROMOTION CRITERIA

Academic Standards for Student's Grades:

The performance of each student in a subject is graded as follows:

X: 90% and above

A: 80 – 89%

B: 70 – 79%

C: 60 – 69%

D: 50 – 59%

E: 40 – 49%

F: 30 – 39%

G: 30% and below

Promotion Criteria: The pass percentage in First Term and Final Exams is 45%. Students falling below 45% are not promoted to next class. They have to retake the examination for promotion.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS, STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY & UNFAIR MEANS

Attendance Requirement:

A student is not allowed to appear in Final Exams if their attendance is less than 90%.

Student's Responsibility:

It is compulsory for all students to appear in all the Monthly/Daily Grand Tests and First Term and Final Exams.

Unfair Means:

Any student found using unfair means or assisting another student during a test/examination is liable to disciplinary action.



HEALTHY LUNCH

All children in Primary are encouraged to bring a packed lunch from home and a water bottle as well. Please give healthy food to your child. The class teachers supervise the lunch breaks. The school canteen is also available that serves reasonably priced and hygienic food.





CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES & SPORTS

All Co-Curricular activities are held as per Schedule of Activities at two levels:

Every child of the school is assigned a House which consists of approximately 100 – 120 students. The children choose their House Officials through an election. The Inter Houses competitions are highly competitive. The activities are diverse such as:

COMMUNICATION

The class teachers usually communicate through:

- ★ the school landline phones
- ★ the class WhatsApp group
- ★ the Parents Portal/App of Modernage

Modernage has an open door policy. We look upon your parents as partners in our efforts to provide care and education to students. They can meet the Class Teacher as well as the Campus Head on any week day after calling the School Secretary and making an appointment to avoid inconvenience.

The Admin Staff are available up to 03:30 pm.

Formal Parent-Teacher Meetings, which are mandatory for parents/guardians to attend, are held:

1. Once in the mid of First Term
2. Twice at the end of First-Term and Final Term
each on the Result Day

For Grade I & II, the parents are presented the Student Portfolios that contain formative assessment record of the children conducted throughout the year.

For Grades III to V, the PTM is held on the result day of the First-Term and Final Exams. The results of children along with their exam papers are handed over to the parents.

PARENTS PORTAL & APP

Modernage has a well-developed Students Portal as well as Students App that can be downloaded from Playstore for Android devices. The user name and password of the portal and app is same and can be obtained from the School Secretary. These give access to parents to view:

- ★ Profile of students
- ★ Monthly attendance
- ★ Monthly fee
- ★ Schedule of Activities
- ★ Important notifications and circulars
- ★ Vacation homework, etc.

The parents can also use the app to:

- ★ Apply for leave





UNIFORM

All children must arrive to school in neat and tidy uniform as per season. The uniform for Grade I & II is available from the school. The boys are expected to have their hair cut short and the girls with long hair must have it tied back. Wearing expensive jewellery is prohibited in school.

PUNCTUALITY & ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is very important for the academic progress of a student. Parents are requested to help us in creating a routine for the children.

- ★ The class teacher must be informed in writing through WhatsApp or the School App if leave is required for the child.
- ★ A medical certificate is required, if a student is absent for more than four days because of illness.
- ★ A short leave is granted in case of extreme emergency only. The parents must come in person to collect the child for short leave.

- ★ A child who has less than 90% of the possible attendance, counted from the date of their admission to the institution is not allowed to take the annual assessment or promotion to next class.
- ★ Names of pupils who remain absent without leave for six consecutive days are struck off the school rolls.
- ★ Readmission depends on the discretion of the Principal and availability of seat.



BELONGINGS OF STUDENTS

Books must be neatly covered and the name of child should be properly and clearly written. All belongings such as bags, colour boxes, lunch boxes, water bottles and art materials should be marked for easy identification. Students are not allowed to bring large amounts of money or other valuable items to school. The school will not be responsible for loss of personal items.

DISPUTES

Students are not allowed to settle their disputes on their own. All serious disciplinary cases are discussed with VPs and in extreme cases these may be referred to the College Council. The VPs take serious action against those who verbally abuse a person based on their caste, religion, mother tongue, region, culture, nationality, social and economic status, or physical, psychological or mental disability.



GREETINGS

Students are advised to adopt the habit of exchange of Islamic greetings i.e. “Assalam- o-Alaikum/Wa-Alaikumusalam” while interacting with fellow students, faculty & staff of the school.





VISITORS & GUESTS

The parents are requested not to bring uninvited guests to school functions. Visitors, including guests are expected to conduct themselves, at all times, in a manner consistent with orderly behaviour in an educational institution. Only the visitors mentioned in the contact list of the child, provided by the parents are allowed to meet them.
