

help the students in developing a pleasing personality having a desire to serve the humanity


develop a mindset in youngsters that supports them in facing challenges of the present world

Groups: The students can choose to study either Biology or Computer Science in Grade IX & X. Additionally, the following combinations are available at Inter level Part I & II:


- i. F.Sc Pre-Medical(Physics, Chemistry, Biology)

THE MODERNAGE WAY


The teachers use the following six step methodology to help you make the best use of your time:



THE HOMEROOM LESSON

It is the first lesson of just 10 minutes immediately after the Morning Assembly. In this lesson, the class teacher takes attendance, discusses policies, checks uniforms, and makes important announcements if any. The students are also encouraged to talk about the problems that they might be facing at school in this time.





You should be able to do the homework on your own at home. Independent work helps to develop your study habits and skills. There is no particular Homework Schedule at this level. The teachers may give you practice work for reinforcement as required. However, it is your own responsibility to revise all the concepts studied in school at home regularly. You will manage your homework easily if you:

Develop a firm routine for homework.

Allocate a specific time and study area.

Control your screen time.

TESTS, EXAMINATION & GRADING POLICY

Following is the schedule for purpose of grading
your academic progress throughout the year:

Grades IX to XII:

I. Weekly Grand Tests:

These are mandatory tests conducted once or twice a week according to a pre-defined date sheet. In case you fail any test, you have to take a re-test the next day after full break. The checked scripts are returned to you and follow up discussion sessions are conducted by teachers to highlight common mistakes. The dates and results are intimated through the portal as well. The pass percentage in these tests is 50%.

ii. Daily Grand Tests:

Daily Grand Tests begin in November for Grade IX & X, and in February for Grade XI & XII. Comprehensive revision and preparation for the Pre-Board Exams is carried out during the Winter Coaching Camp. In case you fail a test, you have to take a re-test next day after the full break. The pass percentage in these tests is 50%.

iii. First Term and Pre-Board Exam:

A three hour exam is conducted for each subject in the midyear and at the end of the academic session of the board classes with due notice of at least 7 days. It is mandatory for all students to pass all the subjects in these exams. The pass percentage in these exams is 45%

iv. In addition, there are class assignments, labs, practical and oral examinations, and projects.



ACADEMIC STANDARDS FOR STUDENT'S GRADES

The performance of each student in a subject is graded as follows:

X: 90% and above	A: 80 – 89%	B: 70 – 79%	C: 60 – 69%
D: 50 – 59%	E: 40 – 49%	F: 30 – 39%	G: 30% and below

Registration for External Board Exams:

The pass percentage in First Term and Final Exams is 45%. Students falling below 45% are not registered for the external Board Exams. They have to retake and pass the examination before they are considered eligible for registration for Board Exam.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS, STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY & UNFAIR MEANS

Attendance Requirement:

A student is not allowed to appear in First Term & Pre-Board Exams if their attendance is less than 90%.

Student's Responsibility:

It is compulsory for all students to appear in all the Weekly/Daily Grand Tests and First Term and Final Exams.

Unfair Means:

Any student found using unfair means or assisting another student during a test/examination is liable to disciplinary action. Use of unfair means generally covers the following, namely:

- i. An attempt to have access to the question paper before the test/examination;
- ii. Use/possession of unauthorized reference material during test/examination;
- iii. Any form of communication by the examinees with anyone in or outside the examination room while the test/examination is in progress; and
- iv. Unauthorized entry into faculty's office or that of his/her staff with the intention of having an access to or tampering with the official record/Examination papers, etc.

HEALTHY LUNCH & UNIFORM

You should avoid junk food and develop good eating habits. All Modernites are encouraged to bring a packed lunch from home. The school canteen is also available that serves reasonably priced and hygienic food.

House Activities

Every student of the Seniors level is assigned a House which consists of approximately 100 – 120 students. The students choose their House Officials through an election. The Inter House competitions are highly competitive. The house tradition is so strong at Modernage that you will hear your friends chanting the slogan, “For School We Try; For House We Die”. The activities are diverse such as:

- * Math Marathon, Sudoku & Rubik’s Cube Competitions
- * Field Trips
- * Sports and games culminating at Annual Sports Gala
- * University Fairs & Aptitude Testing
- * Students Quality Circles culminating at National Convention on Students Quality Circles

CAREER COUNSELLING

Throughout the four years of the Seniors level, a number of activities will be conducted to provide you assistance in career planning so that you can choose the most suitable career path for yourself. Some are as follows:

- * You are helped to make your portfolio consisting of your educational documents, achievement certificates, personal statement, photographs of important events you participated in, and samples of your best work, etc.
- * Aptitude Test is done to help you analyze your individual skills and interests.
- * A number of interactive sessions are conducted to discuss the courses being offered by universities in Pakistan and abroad.
- * A University Fair featuring stalls of renowned universities as well as talks from professionals from different walks of life is conducted each year so that you can gain first-hand experience about the programs, facilities and scholarships being offered by universities.
- * The social media of the school is regularly updated to keep you abreast of the call for applications from different universities.
- * University visits are also arranged.

INTERNATIONAL EXPOSURE

At Modernage we believe that you are a Global Citizen who has to be prepared for performing your best in the international arena. A number of Student Exchange Programs are conducted with International Partners in countries like Sri Lanka, India, Japan, Turkey, Mauritius, UK, Iran, Bangladesh, Nepal, China, etc. On a number of occasions, international delegates are invited to interact with you and share their experiences.



COMMUNICATION

The class teachers usually communicate through:

- ★ the school landline phones
- ★ the class WhatsApp group
- ★ the Parents Portal/App of Modernage

Modernage has an open door policy. We look upon your parents as partners in our efforts to provide care and education to students. They can meet the Class Teacher as well as the Campus Head on any week day after calling the School Secretary and making an appointment to avoid inconvenience.

The Admin Staff are available up to 03:30 pm.

Formal Parent-Teacher Meetings, which are mandatory for parents/guardians to attend, are held:

1. Once in the mid of First Term
2. Twice at the end of First-Term and Final Term each on the Result Day

PARENTS PORTAL & APP

Modernage has a well-developed Parents Portal as well as Parents App that can be downloaded from Playstore for Android devices. The user name and password of the portal and app is same and can be obtained from the School Secretary. These give access to parents to view:

- ★ Academic Progress of all their children in a number of areas at a single platform.
- ★ Profile of students
- ★ Monthly attendance
- ★ Monthly fee
- ★ Schedule of Activities
- ★ Important notifications and circulars
- ★ Vacation homework, etc.

The parents can also use the app to:

- ★ Register their complaints online
- ★ Apply for leave



PUNCTUALITY & ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is very important for the academic progress of a student. All Modernites are expected to create a routine for themselves.

- ★ The class teacher must be informed in writing through WhatsApp or the School App if leave is required.
- ★ A medical certificate is required, if a student is absent for more than four days because of illness.
- ★ A short leave is granted in case of extreme emergency only. The parents must come in person to collect you for short leave.
- ★ A student who has less than 90% of the possible attendance, counted from the date of their admission to the institution is not allowed to take the annual examination or promotion to next class.
- ★ Names of pupils who remain absent without leave for six consecutive days are struck off the school rolls.
- ★ Readmission depends on the discretion of the Principal and availability of seat.

DISCIPLINE

★ Dress Code:

A complete list of the uniform items required is available on the website of Modernage. All students must arrive to school in neat and tidy uniform as per season. The uniform is easily available from the local market. The boys are expected to have their hair cut short and the girls with long hair must have it tied back.

★ Use of Electronic Devices/Mobile Phones:

Using electronic gadgets especially mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the school especially classrooms, examination/lecture halls, labs and library.

★ Use of Drugs:

Modernage is committed to providing an environment that is free from the problems associated with the use and abuse of illegal substances. Any student using, selling, possessing, distributing, transferring, or manufacturing illegal substances in any setting and at any time will be committing a serious violation of the Code of Conduct of Modernage and will face swift and severe disciplinary action and probable dismissal. The use of all tobacco products, including but not limited to snuff, dip, chewing tobacco, cigarettes, cigars, and pipe tobacco, is strictly prohibited in Modernage at all times. All students in violation of this prohibition shall be subject to progressive disciplinary consequences. Repeated violations may result in dismissal.

Further all Modernites are expected to avoid:

- i. wearing shabby or torn clothing
- ii. putting on excessive makeup or wearing expensive jewellery.
- iii. wearing untidy, gaudy or immodest dress in school functions when permissible.
- iv. wearing unprofessional attire in formal programmes

DISCIPLINE

★ Off-Campus Conduct:

The conduct of Modernites outside campus premises should be such that it does not adversely affect the reputation/image of Modernage.

★ Littering/Vandalism:

It is your responsibility to keep the Campus environment clean and tidy. No littering or trash should be carelessly thrown or left on the Campus premises. The designated waste boxes/baskets should be used to deposit the refuse. Students found writing on walls and school furniture will be dealt with firmly.

★ Greetings:

Students are advised to adopt the habit of exchange of Islamic greetings i.e. "Assalam- o-Alaikum/ Wa-Alaikumusalam" while interacting with fellow students, faculty & staff of the school.

★ Disputes:

Students are not allowed to settle their disputes on their own. All serious disciplinary cases are discussed with VPs and in extreme cases these may be referred to the College Council. The VPs take serious action against those who verbally abuse a person based on their caste, religion, mother tongue, region, culture, nationality, social and economic status, or physical, psychological or mental disability. You can launch your complaints both orally and in writing. Feel free to approach your teachers, the Academic Coordinator, the Discipline Incharge or the Vice Principal for any difficulty that you might be facing. All efforts will be made to provide you a satisfactory solution for your problems.



VISITORS & GUESTS

The students are not allowed to bring uninvited guests to school functions. Visitors, including guests are expected to conduct themselves, at all times, in a manner consistent with orderly behaviour in an educational institution. Only the visitors mentioned in the contact list of the students, provided by the parents are allowed to meet them.
